Duration of The Course

Four years (Eight Semesters) as per the academic calendar of The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

Admission Process:

Admission Requirements:

- Male and female candidates of Indian origin are eligible.
- Minimum age for admission is 17 years, and the maximum age is 35 years as of December 31 of the year in which admission is sought.
- Candidates must be medically fit.
- Color blind candidates are eligible if they wear color-corrective contact lenses or spectacles.
- Married candidates are also eligible for admission.
- Admissions are conducted once a year.
- Candidates must appear for a computer-based entrance test conducted by the competent authority.



Minimum educational qualification:

- Candidates must have passed the 12th standard examination (10+2) with Science and obtained at least 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology combined, with English passed individually.
- For SC/ST/OBC candidates, the minimum required marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology combined is 40%, with English passed individually.
- Eligibility also includes candidates from State Open Schools recognized by the State Government and the National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by the Central Government, provided they have studied Science subjects and English.
- English must be a compulsory subject in 10+2 for eligibility to Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- Changes to the admission process or selection criteria will be made according to notifications from the Indian Nursing Council, Tamil Nadu Nursing Council, and the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University.

Any concealed/wrong information will lead to disqualification at any time. Where false statements in the application are discovered after admission has been granted, the admission will be cancelled, and fees paid will not be refunded.

Certificates and Documents to be submitted During the Time of Admission

The following original certificates/Documents should be submitted during admission

- a) Age Proof: High School Certificate/Higher Secondary Certificate/Birth Certificate.
- b) Qualifying Examination Certificate- HSCE, HSLC and SSLC
- c) Transfer Certificate
- d) Conduct Certificate
- e) Community Certificate (computerized)
- f) Nativity Certificate
- g) Migration and Eligibility certificate for other state candidates.
- h) Recent passport size photo with white background (10)
- i) Income Certificate(Latest)
- j) Aadhar card (updated after 15 years and linked with the candidates mobile number (not parents)
- k) Bank passbook copy (MICR, IFSC Code & Aadhar should be linked to candidates mobile number, Latest Single account)
- l) First Graduate Certificate(If eligible)
- m) Parents photograph and Local Guardian authorization letter with Photograph

Medical Fitness

The candidates selected for admission will have to undergo medical examination at SCAD Medical Centre. If the candidate is found medically unfit, she/he will not be admitted



Fees and Payment

- College and Hostel fees of each year should be paid at the beginning of the Academic Year. And the first College and Hostel fees to be paid during the time of Admission. The exact fees to be paid by the students of all categories will be intimated at the time of admission/selection.
- Students will not be allowed to attend university examination unless she/he complies with all the admission requirements and pays all the fees for the year.
- Fees once remitted will not be refunded.

Discontinuation

- A student who discontinues the course after admission but before the commencement of the Course will not be entitled for refund of the fees already paid and deposits made to the institution. In such a case, an amount equal to 10% of the total fees payable will be deducted as service charges.
- Students who voluntarily withdraw from the study during the course shall be required to pay full fees of the entire course.
